The Elmezzi Graduate School of Molecular Medicine, located in Manhasset, NY, is an individually tailored and accelerated three-year doctoral program awarding a **PhD degree to individuals who hold an MD or equivalent**. The graduate school directly addresses the crucial need for physician-scientists trained to conduct translational and clinically relevant research.

**Open to national (US) and international applicants.** The program is **salary supported and tuition free**.

Mission: Provide superior academic training to physicians to train the next generation of leaders in the field of translational research.

Program information: This is a **select program (<15 students)** integrated in a large research and hospital environment. Northwell Health consists of 23 hospitals, over 800 ambulatory facilities, and 77,000 employees. The Feinstein Institutes for Medical Research is Northwell's research institution and provides all the facilities and resources for the Graduate School. It is among the top six percent of research institutions that receive funding from the National Institutes of Health (NIH). The PhD degree requires completing a substantial body of scholarly research under the mentorship of Elmezzi faculty, coupled with a focused core curriculum and seminar-style courses. Possible research topics (see link below for list of faculty) and methods are wide and **not limited to molecular medicine** (e.g., intracranial EEG, bioelectronic medicine, big data science etc.).

Faculty: 74 full-time; 3 emeritus; 4 adjunct    Faculty: Student ratio: approximately 4:1

Credits: Students must complete at least 72 credits to graduate with a PhD from Elmezzi.

Tuition: The Elmezzi Graduate School is tuition-free.

Salary and benefits: starting salary of approximately \$72,500 plus fringe, benefits.

Important Dates:

- **Application due: February 1<sup>st</sup>**
- Interviews are conducted in March
- Acceptance decisions before April
- The school functions on a year-round calendar, with most students admitted on July 1.
